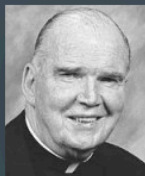


# Father Robert G. Gibney



## Robert Gibney Obituary

**F**ather Robert G. Gibney of Caldwell, N.J., died Friday, Jan. 6, 2012. Visiting will be at the Dancy Funeral Home, 9 Smull Ave., Caldwell, on Tuesday, Jan. 10, 2012, from 2 to 4 and 7 to 9 p.m., and at St. Aloysius Church, Caldwell, on Wednesday, Jan. 11, 2012, from 9 to 10:30 a.m., when a Mass of Christian Burial will be offered. Interment will be at Holy Cross Cemetery in North Arlington, N.J. Born in Jersey City, N.J., Father Gibney graduated from Seton Hall University and was ordained in 1954 from Immaculate Conception Seminary, Darlington, N.J., in St. Patrick's Pro-Cathedral, Newark, N.J. Father Gibney's assignments included St. Cecelia's, Kearny, N.J.; Darlington Seminary (dean), Mahwah, N.J.; Sacred Heart Vailsburg, Newark, N.J.; St. Mary's, Dumont, N.J.; St. Catherine's, Cedar Grove, N.J. (pastor); Overlook Medical Center, Summit, N.J. (chaplain), and Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, Ridgewood, N.J. (pastor emeritus), where he served until his retirement in 1997. A Navy veteran, Father served during World War II and was honorably discharged in 1946. He also served in the U.S. Navy Chaplain Corps from 1965 to 1975, achieving the rank of lieutenant commander. Father Gibney was the son of the late Joseph and Margaret Gibney and brother of the late Joseph and John Gibney. He is survived by his sister, Peggie Gibney Kology, and 10 nieces and nephews.
