

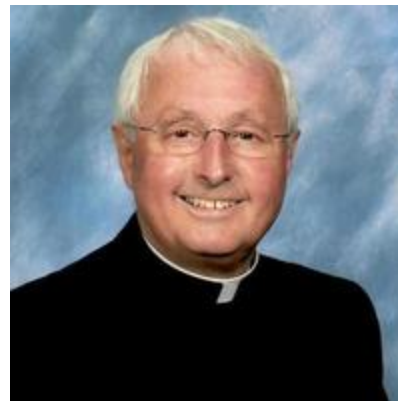

Rev. George A. Desjardins

(November 12, 1932 - May 26, 2024)

The Reverend George A. Desjardins was called to his rest and to the glory of the Resurrection promised by the Lord on May 26, 2024. He was 91 years old.

Father Desjardins was born on November 12, 1932, in Dover, New Hampshire. He was ordained a priest on May 23, 1959, by the Most Reverend Matthew F. Brady, D.D., at Saint Joseph Cathedral in Manchester. Father Desjardins studied at St. Charles Seminary in Sherbrooke, PQ, Canada and Saint Francis College, Biddeford, Maine. He completed his ecclesiastical studies at Christ the King Seminary in St. Bonaventure, New York.



Father Desjardins served as associate pastor of Saint Peter Parish in Farmington; Saint Anthony Parish, Manchester; Sacred Heart Parish in Lebanon and Saint John the Baptist Parish in Manchester.

Father Desjardins served as pastor of Holy Redeemer Parish in West Lebanon; Sacred Heart Parish, Manchester, and Saint George Parish in Manchester where he served until his retirement on June 26, 2002. Afterwards, he became active in ministry at St. John the Evangelist Parish, Concord, NH.

Family members include a brother, Ret. Colonel Robert J. Desjardins of Ocean Springs, MS; a sister-in-law, Theresa (Moscato) Desjardins; two nephews, David and his wife, Rebekah (Parent) , and Steve and his wife, Stacy (Pham); a niece, Anne (Desjardins) Benson and her husband, David; and several grandnieces and grandnephews.

Father Desjardins will lie in repose on Wednesday, June 5, 2024, at 9:00 am at Saint Joseph Cathedral, 145 Lowell Street, Manchester, NH.
