

**PILIE**--Reverend Alvin J. Pilie, S.J., 1915-1986. Father Alvin J. Pilie of the Society of Jesus and former pastor of immaculate Conception Church in Albuquerque died in New Orleans on November 21. Father Pilie, a member of an old and distinguished New Orleans family, was born on June 23, 1915. He entered the Jesuits on August 30, 1932 and he was ordained a priest on June 17, 1945. He was an associate professor of Sacred Scripture at Loyola University in New Orleans from 1953 until 1968. At that time he was assigned to Immaculate Conception Church here in Albuquerque as an assistant pastor. He became pastor in 1980. In 1983 he was assigned as pastor of St. Anne's Church in West Palm Beach, Florida. The year following he was appointed superior of the Jesuit community in Miami until this year. Fr. Pilie was a very active member of the Cursillo Movement and was the associate director of the Archdiocesan Cursillo Movement in New Mexico. Fr. Pilie retained a very deep affection for and remembrance of the members of the Cursillo group and invited all past and present members of the Cursillos and members of Immaculate Conception parish to his funeral before he died. Fr. Pilie, son of the late Walter E. Pilie, St. and the late Edith L. Mahen was the beloved brother of Harold A. Pilie, Sr., Lloyd A. Pilie, Edmund G. Pilie, and the late Walter E.
