Fr. Salvatore A. Rodino worked in the Diocese of Albany until he was removed from ministry in October 2009. His removal came after a Diocesan Review Board found "reasonable grounds" to believe he sexually abused a male teenager at Blessed Sacrament in Albany in the 1980s. Fr. Rodino is listed on the Diocese of Albany's lists of "Clergy Credibly Accused While Serving in the Diocese of Albany." Fr. Rodino's current status as a priest, his whereabouts, and access to children are unknown.

Note from BishopAccountability.org: The *Official Catholic Directory* aims to report the whereabouts of Catholic priests in the United States on January 1 of the *Directory's* publication year. Our working assumption is that a priest listed in the *Directory* for a given year was at the same assignment for part of the previous year as well. However, Kennedy and Sons will sometimes accept updates well into the year of publication. Diocesan clergy records are rarely available to correct this information. The *Directory* is also sometimes misleading or wrong. The above assignment record shows *Directory* years, therefore 1981-1983 reflects 1980-1983, 1984 reflects 1983-1984, and so on.
