Troy Priest Joins Army As Chaplain

Rev. Paul J. Bondi, son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph P. Bondi of 18 Griswold Avenue, has enlisted as a Chaplain in the U. S. Air Force.

Father Bondi has been commissioned a first lieutenant and will report Monday to Camp Kilmer, N. J. From there he will proceed to Godman Air Base, Ky., where he is to be stationed.

Previous to his enlistment, Father Bondi served as assistant pastor at St. Mary's Church, Frankfort; Mount Carmel Church, Schenectady; St. Anthony's Church, Herkimer; and St. Peter's Church, Stillwater.

Father Bondi, a native of Troy, was ordained to the priesthood April 17, 1948 by Most Rev. Edmund F. Gibbons, D.D., Bishop of the Albany Diocese.

He graduated from Sacred Heart School and Catholic Central High School. Father Bondi attended Siena College and completed his theological studies at St. Joseph's Seminary, Dunwoodie.
