

Rev. Edward Leroux To Be Ordained May 26

The Rev. Edward Leroux, son of Mrs. Corinne Leroux and the late Albert Leroux, 31 McDonald St., Glens Falls, will be raised to the ranks of priesthood of the Catholic Church by the Most Rev. William A. Scully, D.D., Bishop of Albany, at the ordination ceremony May 26 in the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, Albany.

A graduate of St. Alphonsus School, Class of 1944, the Rev. Leroux attended La Salette Seminary in Hartford, Conn., two years and graduated from St. Mary's Academy in Glens Falls, Class of 1948. He attended St. Andrew's Seminary in Rochester for two years of college and completed his philosophical and theological training in St. Mary's Seminary, Baltimore, Md.

The Rev. Leroux, a member of St. Alphonsus Parish, will celebrate his First Solemn Mass in the Great Hall of St. Mary's Academy on Sunday, May 27. Archpriest for the occasion will be the Rev. Paul A. Leduc, pastor of St. Alphonsus Church. The Rev. Vincent B. Jaracz will be deacon and the Rev. Rene Levesque of Fall River, Mass., will be subdeacon. The Rev. C. Henri Tessier, pastor of St. Paul's Church, Hudson Falls, will preach the sermon. Robert Fleig, S.J., will be master of ceremonies and Ernest Leroux will be thurifer.

Music for the occasion will include Mass of the Holy Family; Processional; Offertory; "Panis Angelicus" to be sung by Joseph Bazinet; and Recessional, "O Magnify the Lord."
