Rev. Hatela To Sing 1st Mass Sunday

The Rev. Robert Stephen Hatela, of Troy, N. Y., formerly of Schuylkill County, was ordained Saturday, May 28, in the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, Albany, N. Y., into the Roman Catholic priesthood. Officiating was Bishop William A. Scully, of the Albany diocese.

Father Hatela is the son of Michael Hatela, formerly of St. Clair, and Mrs. Sophie Przybuy's Hatela, formerly of Minersville, now residents of Troy. He prepared for the Holy Priesthood at St. Andrew's Seminary, Rochester, N. Y., and St. Jerome's College, Kitchner-Ontario, Canada. In 1955, he entered Our Lady of Angels Seminary at Niagara University, New York, to complete his philosophical and Theological studies.

Father Hatela will offer his First Solemn Mass at 10:30 a. m., on Sunday, June 5 in St. Stanislaus Church, Minersville. Assisting him will be Rev. James Perrelli, Deacon, and Rev. Joseph Anselment, Subdeacon. Rev. John S. Baruch, pastor of St. Stanislaus Church, will preach the sermon.

A dinner and reception will follow at the new Rokoer Hotel, Minersville.
