



REV. EDWARD N. LEROUX

Fr. Leroux Columbiettes Chaplain

Rev. Edward N. Leroux, assistant pastor of St. Joseph's Church, Cohoes, has been appointed as chaplain to the Cohoes Columbiettes by Most Rev. William A. Scully, D.D., bishop of Albany, it was announced yesterday by Mrs. Nelda I. McKee, president of the group.

Father Leroux was named to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of Rev. Lionel A. Guillaume, former assistant pastor of St. Bernard's Church, Cohoes, who was recently transferred to Whitehall.

A native of Glens Falls and a graduate of St. Mary's Academy, that city, Father Leroux studied at St. Mary's Seminary, Rochester, and took his philosophy and theology courses at St. Mary's Seminary, Baltimore, Md. He was ordained in May of 1958.

Before coming to Cohoes in 1960, Father Leroux was stationed at the Church of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Edmeston, Our Lady of Victory Church, Troy, and St. Mary's Church, Gloversville. He was appointed as Catholic chaplain to the Cohoes Police and Fire Departments in April of 1961.

Mrs. McKee also announced that committees will meet tonight to discuss plans for three future programs. Included will be a social on Feb. 12, the annual corporate Holy Communion and breakfast program, under the direction of a committee headed by Miss Mary Durocher and Miss Constance Perry, and the 10th anniversary observance in April, under the direction of Miss Alice Turpin.
