## Fr. Guzielek Dies At 67; Ill For Week

Rev. Ladislaus E. Guzielek, 67, former pastor of Immaculate Conception Church, Watervliet, died Sunday at St. Peter's Hospital, Albany, where he had been a patient for a week. He was pastor of the Church of the Holy Family at Downsville.

Father Guzielek was born in Amsterdam Feb. 8, 1897, and was graduated from St. John Kanty School, Erie, Pa., and St. Bernard's Seminary in Rochester. He was ordained to the priesthood on June 24, 1924.

Following his ordination he served as assistant at St. Stanislaus Church, Amsterdam. His first pastorate was at All Saints Church, Granville.

He became pastor at Watervliet in September, 1933, serving for 11 years.

In January, 1944, he became pastor of St. Adelbert's Church, Schenectady, serving until 1961 when he was assigned to the Downsville church.

He is survived by three brothers, Frank, John and Edward Guzielek of Schenectady, and nieces and nephews.

His body will lie in state in the rectory of his church until 4 p.m. today when the Office of the Dead will be sung by clergymen of the diocese. The body will then be taken to the church where at 11 a.m. tomorrow Most Rev. William A. Scully, D.D., bishop of Albany Catholic Diocese, will celebrate the Solemn Pontifical Requiem Mass. Interment will be in St. Stanislaus Cemetery, Amsterdam.
