

Rev. Edward Leroux To Address PTA

The Rev. Edward N. Leroux, assistant pastor of St. Joseph's Church, Cohoes, and a former curate of St. Alphonsus Church, will be guest speaker at a meeting of St. Alphonsus Parent-Teacher Assoc. tomorrow at 8:15 p.m. in the school auditorium.

William Bazinet, president, will conduct the business session. A report on the annual dance sponsored by the PTA Oct. 28 will be given by John Brilling, dance chairman, who will present a check to the Rev. C. Henri Tessier, pastor, on behalf of the association. The check, representing proceeds from the "Evening in Paris Ball" will be used to help pay for construction of the new school.

Father Leroux, who will be introduced by Father Tessier, is a native of Glens Falls. He is a graduate of St. Alphonsus School and St. Mary's Academy; St. Andrew's Seminary, Rochester, and St. Mary's Seminary, Baltimore, Md. The priest was ordained May 26, 1956, in Immaculate Conception Cathedral, Albany, by the Most Rev. William A. Scully, D.D., Bishop of Albany. He celebrated his first Mass in St. Mary's Great Hall May 27 of that year. Father Leroux is a former assistant pastor of Our Lady of Victory Church, Troy.
