

Boys Town to Set Up Radio Station

A bequest from Patrick Norton, nephew of Boys Town founder Edward Flanagan and his longtime working associate who died last year, will be used to establish a radio station at Boys Town, it was announced Tuesday.

The Rev. James Kelly, a radio enthusiast and Boys Town's spiritual affairs director, will manage the AM station that will be carried by the house current in each of the home's residential buildings.

Kelly said the station will be known as KRBT or "Radio Boys Town" and its broadcast frequency is yet undetermined. He said the station should be on the air next month.

"This will be a non-profit, Christian broadcasting station, proclaiming the good word," Kelly said. "This is an especially beautiful way to fulfill the wishes of Pat. As a deacon in the Catholic Church he was devoted to the idea of proclaiming the good news of Christ."
