

## Rev. John Klebauskas

Rev. John P. Klebauskas, Teresian House, Washington Ave., Albany, N.Y. died Saturday.

Born in Scranton, he was the son of the late Joseph and Agatha M. Mazukaitis Klebauskas. He was educated and graduated from St. Joseph's Parochial Grade School, and Marinapolis Academy, Thompson, Conn and entered the Seminary at Marion Hills, Ill. He was ordained in Chicago on May 16, 1948, and received his doctorate of theology at Angleicum University, Rome, Italy, in January 1951.

He was assigned in Albany as former instructor of religion at Catholic Central High School, Troy, N.Y. and St. John's Academy, Rennissler, N.Y. and was then assigned to St. Lawrence Rome Catholic Parish in Troy, N.Y. He was later assigned to Holy Spirit Parish, East Green Bush, N.Y.

He was former director of Camp Scully, Troy, N.Y. from 1958 to 1970. The former pastor of St. Anthony's Church in Albany, Sacred Heart Church, Berlin, N.Y. and St. Paul's Church, Hancock, N.Y. In August, 1980, he was named chaplain of the Teresian House.

Surviving are a brother, Peter, Windsor, Conn.; six sisters, Mrs. Adele Kazulkynas, Center Barbor, N.H.; Mrs. Minnie Muskett and Mrs. Isabel Peteavage, Scranton; Mrs. Lillian Grakowsky, East Hartford, Conn.; Sister Liguori, SJC, Brockton, Mass.; Miss Agnes Klebauskas, Coral Gables, Fla.

The body will lie in state in St. Joseph's Church, North Scranton, Tuesday 6 to 9 p.m. The funeral will be held Wednesday at 9:30 a.m. with Mass of Christian Burial at St. Joseph's Church. Interment, Cathedral Cemetery.
