

## **Kelly resigns at Boys Town**

**BOYS TOWN (UPI) —** The Rev. James Kelly, director of spiritual affairs at Boys Town for the past seven years, has resigned to return to New York, his native state.

Kelly, 50, said Monday that he will return to Troy, N.Y., to become administrator of St. Peter's parish for five months while the pastor is on leave.

Kelly is the second top Boys Town official to resign in two weeks. Robert Bigley, director of finance, resigned before Christmas to pursue opportunities in the investment field.

Kelly has served as Boys Town's chaplain and head of the religious education department, overseeing Catholic and Protestant programs.
