Thomas D. George, 62, passed away on January 2, 2011 after succumbing to cancer. Thomas was born on September 21, 1948 at Fort Edward. He was the son of Herbert A. George and Catherine L. George (deceased); and brother to Robert Eastman, Cathy Ann Stone and Herbert George Jr. He was survived by long time friend, Harry Harcourt. Thomas graduated from St. Vincent De Paul's High School, Siena College and entered the seminary at Aurora. He was ordained a Catholic priest from June 1979, where he served the faithful, until 1993 where he resigned and moved to St. Petersburg, Fla. He resided over Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church in Gloversville, a congregation in Amsterdam, and St. Alphonsus in Glens Falls. Thomas was also an administrator at Rhinebeck Country School. Upon resigning the priesthood and moving to Florida, he became an administrator, social worker, and educator for the state until 2010. He was an avid stamp collector, coin collector, and historian.
