Will Be Ordained

William McGlynn To Become Priest

Central Islip—Rev. William J. A. McGlynn, son of Mrs. Elizabeth McGlynn of Pineview Blvd., and the late Joseph McGlynn, will be ordained as a Priest in the Roman Catholic Church on Saturday, June 15. The Most Rev. Thomas E. Molloy, Bishop of Brooklyn, will confer priestly orders on 35 young men in St. James Cathedral, Brooklyn.

Rev. McGlynn, will offer his First Mass at St. John of God's Church at 11 A.M., June 16.

He was born in Central Islip and completed his elementary schooling at St. John of God's Parochial School. He graduated from high school here in 1938 and from Mount St. Mary's College, Emmitsburg, Md., in 1942. Rev. McGlynn entered the Immaculate Conception Seminary, Huntington, in September 1942.

Rev. McGlynn will be assigned to the Diocese of Brooklyn. A reception for Rev. McGlynn will be held in St. John of God's school hall from 3 to 7 P.M., June 16.
