

Problem in India Cited

The Indian Government's policy of restricting activities of foreign missionaries is one of the serious problems faced by the Catholic Church in India, according to the Rev. Protasio Soares, councilor general of the Indian Mission Society of St. Francis Xavier. He is visiting Buffalo under auspices of the Society for the Propagation of the Faith. Father Soares, who seeks aid for the Church in India, is stationed in the Portuguese colony of Goa on India's west coast.

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
