**Rev. Antoine Attea
To Offer Mass at
SS. Peter and Paul**

The Rev. Fr. Antoine P. Attea, who was ordained at the North American College in Rome on December 20, 1958, will offer his first solemn high Mass this Sunday, Aug. 2, at 10:30 a. m. at SS. Peter and Paul Church, Williamsville. Archpriest will be the Very Rev. Msgr. George Zimpfer, pastor of the church. His brother, the Rev. Fr. Joseph G. Attea will be deacon, and a cousin, Rev. Fr. Joseph D. Joseph will be subdeacon. The Very Rev. Msgr. Ralph M. Miller, rector of the Diocesan Preparatory Seminary, will preach the sermon.

Father Attea is the son of Mr. and Mrs. George H. Attea of 79 Royal Pkwy., Williamsville. Before returning home, the Rev. Fr. Attea toured Egypt, Lebanon, the Holy Land and Europe. He will be at his home for several weeks before being assigned to a parish.
