

Priest Marking 25th Anniversary

The Rev. Sigmund Haremski, of St. Florian Catholic Church in Standish will celebrate his 25th anniversary as an ordained priest at a mass to be said 1 p.m. Sunday at St. Florian's by The Most Rev. Francis F. Reh.

Father Haremski was ordained on Feb. 24, 1945, in St. Mary's Cathedral by the late William F. Murphy, first Bishop of the Diocese of Saginaw. He said his first mass the following day here in Holy Rosary Church.

Born Oct. 20, 1917, in Saginaw, Father Haremski graduated from Saginaw High School and from Assumption University, Windsor, Canada, in 1941, where he received a bachelor of arts degree in honor philosophy. He received a bachelor of sacred theology degree from St. Mary's Seminary, Baltimore, Md., in 1943.

He was first assigned as an assistant at St. Mary's in Alpena from 1945-49, then at St. Stanislaus in Bay City, 1949-50, and at Saginaw St. Andrew's, 1950-51. His first parish assignment was at St. Michael's Church, Wilmot, with orders to establish a mission church in Mayville. St. Joseph's Church of Mayville became a new parish October 28, 1951. In 1956, Father Haremski became pastor at St. Felix in Pinnebog where he left in 1960 to accept his present assignment in St. Florian.
