

**Haremski, Rev. Fr.
Sigmund J.
Saginaw, Michigan**

Rev. Fr. Sigmund J. Haremski was born in Saginaw, Michigan on October 20, 1917, the son of the late Stanley and Stella Haremski. He graduated from Holy Rosary Grade School and later from Saginaw High School. He received a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Honour Philosophy from the University of Windsor, Canada. He studied Theology at St. Mary Seminary, Baltimore, Maryland and obtained a degree in Bachelor of Sacred Theology. He was ordained to the Priesthood on February 24, 1945 at St. Mary Cathedral by Bishop William F. Murphy, the First Bishop of the Diocese of Saginaw. His appointments as an assistant were to St. Mary, Alpena; St. Stanislaus, Bay City, and St. Andrew, Saginaw. He was appointed First Resident Pastor of St. Michael Church, Wilmot and established a Mission Church at St. Joseph in Mayville. He was also Pastor of St. Felix, Pinnebog; St. Florian, Standish; St. Hedwig, Bay City; and St. Mary, Nine Mile. He retired from Active Administration of a Parish on September 7, 1982.

He is survived by 1 brother and 2 sisters: Floyd Haremski; Helen Wickwire and Marianne Smith, all of Saginaw; 6 nieces and 10 nephews; his brother, Stanley predeceased him in 1978.

Mass of Christian Burial will take place at 11 a.m. Thursday, December 19, 1991 at St. George Catholic Church, Saginaw. Most Rev. Bishop Kenneth Untener and Brother Priests of the Saginaw Diocese will officiate with interment in St. Olivet Cemetery. Friends may call at the Snow Funeral Home, 3775 N.
