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ALBANY, N.Y. - Rev. Robert W. Taylor, pastor of the Church of St. Margaret Mary in Albany, died at the rectory on Tudor Rd. Born in Albany, he attended Mater Christi Seminary and Our Lady of Angels Major Seminary in Glenmont before he was ordained in 1967. From 1967 to 1979, he served as an associate at the Church of the Sacred Heart on Troy. From 1970 to 1976, he served as the chaplain at St. Mary's Hospital in Amsterdam and from 1973 to 1976 was the diocesan director of hospital chaplains. He served as the pastor of the Church of St. Mary in Little Falls from 1976 to 1981. From that time until his death, he was the pastor at the Church of St. Margaret Mary in Albany, and from 1989 to 1992 was a diocesan consultant. He worked in the banking industry before entering the seminary. He served as a chaplain's assistant in the U.S. Army.
