FATHERS AURELIAN AND EDWIN IN NEW POSTS AT RYAN HIGH

Bishop Ryan High School will have a new assistant principal and a new athletic director when it re-opens next month, but both will be familiar faces to the pupils.

The Rev. Aurelian Brzezniak, OFM Conv., the new assistant principal, and the Rev. Edwin Agonis, OFM Conv., the new athletic director, have been teaching at the school since 1947.

Father Aurelian is a native of Buffalo and a graduate of East High School. He attended Canisius College and St. Joseph Cupertino College in Ellicott City, Md. He is a graduate of St. Hyacinth Seminary, Granby, Mass. He has been teaching English, Latin and religion since he came to Bishop Ryan after doing parish work two years in Chicopee, Mass.

Father Edwin, also a graduate of St. Hyacinth Seminary, received his master-of-science degree from St. Bonaventure University. A graduate of St. Francis High School in Athol Springs, he taught there after his return from Poland at the close of the war. He has been teaching mathematics at Bishop Ryan.
