Franciscan To Address Mothers' Unit

Rev. Eusebius Arundel, O.F.M., of the Siena College faculty will be guest speaker at a meeting of the Mothers Club of St. Joseph's School, Cohoes, tomorrow at 8 p.m. in the school hall.

Following his graduation in 1943 from St. Bonaventure College, Olean, Father Arundel attended Catholic University in Washington, D.C., and was graduated in 1949 with master's degrees in psychiatry and psychology. He became a member of the faculty at Siena in 1949 and has taught psychology, remedial reading and visual education. He has headed the guidance center at the college since 1950 and in that year initiated a parent-child relations study.
