

TIMON TEACHER MARKS 25th YEAR IN PRIESTHOOD

Irish airs will predominate when friends of Rev. Linus Hennessy, OFM, of Bishop Timon High School, celebrates the 25th anniversary of his ordination at 9 PM June 16 in Carpenters Hall, 300 Kensington Ave.

The County Cork native, a professor of German at the high school, entered the Franciscan order in Killarney. He was ordained in Galway in 1942. He taught in St. Bernardine College, Buckingham, England, and subsequently did mission work in Australia.

Father Hennessy came here in September 1954. At Timon, he has been moderator of the football team 10 years and has been moderator of the Father's Club and of the alumni.

Father Hennessy will be principal concelebrant June 18 at a 10 o'clock Mass in the high school marking his jubilee. The Rev. Timothy Quinn, OFM, former Timon principal, will preach. A breakfast reception will follow.
