Rev. Joseph Roth To Become Priest

Rev. Joseph S. Roth, S. J., son of Mrs. G. Stuart Roth, 108 Wellesley rd., and the late Dr. G. Stuart Roth, will be ordained to the priesthood at Woodstock college, Woodstock, Md., Sunday. The ordaining prelate will be Most Rev. John M. McNamara, D. D., administrator of the archdioceses of Baltimore and Washington, D. C.

After 13 years of study and prayer, Father Roth will return home to celebrate his first solemn high mass Sunday, June 29, in the Church of the Most Holy Rosary. The pastor of the church, Very Rev. Msgr. Howard C. McDowell, will act as archpriest, and Rev. Joseph F. Cantillon, S. J., of the Institute of Social Order, St. Louis, Mo., will preach the sermon.

Father Roth was graduated from Most Holy Rosary high school in 1933 and attended Holy Cross college two years. He entered the Society of Jesus at Wernersville, Pa., in 1935, and pronounced the first vows of the society two years later. After one year of classical studies and three years of philosophy at St. Ignatius House of Studies, Manhasset, and Woodstock college, he taught three years at Xavier high school, New York city.

He then returned to Woodstock college for the study of sacred theology preparatory to ordination to the priesthood.
