

Patrick G. Sheridan Becomes Redemptorist Priest June 19

The Rev. Patrick G. Sheridan, C.S.S.R., son of Mrs. Freda Sheridan, member of St. Gregory's church, North East, will be ordained to the priesthood for work in the Redemptorist order on Sunday, June 19, in the Monastery chapel of Mount St. Alphonsus, Esopus, N. Y., by Cardinal Francis Spellman, Archbishop of New York.

The Redemptorist will sing his First Solemn Mass on Sunday, June 26, in the North

Rector to Speak

The preacher at the Mass will be the Very Rev. Raymond Hefner, C.S.S.R., rector of the college.

Patrick Sheridan followed his vocation for the religious life in the Redemptorist order by entering the preparatory training course at St. Mary's, North East, after the completion of his grade school studies. After the four-year high school and two-year college course at North East, Father Sheridan entered the Redemptorist novitiate of St. Mary's at Ilchester, Md. After his year's novitiate at Ilchester, he entered the major seminary of the Redemptorists at Esopus, from where he will be ordained, having completed five years' study of theology.
