

To Be Ordained

The Rev. Mr. Maurus Schenck, C.P., son of Mr. and Mrs. William M. Schenck of 25 Kent St., is one of 13 Passionists who will be ordained priests, Feb. 28, by the Most Rev. James A. McNulty, Auxiliary Bishop of Newark, N. J., at a pontifical mass at St. Michael's Monastery Church, in Union City, N. J.

Father Schenck will celebrate his first solemn high mass at St. Justin's Church here, March 2, at 11 a. m. A reception in his honor will be held later that day from 3 to 5 p. m., in the church hall.

Father Schenck, an only child, was born Nov. 16, 1922 in New Haven. He attended Rawson School, Weaver High School and New Britain Teachers College and entered Holy Cross Seminary, Dunkirk, N. Y., in 1942.

He was professed a Passionist, Aug. 15, 1946, at St. Paul's Monastery, Pittsburgh. Subsequently he studied at Passionist monasteries in Scranton, Pa., Baltimore, Md., and Union City, N. J.

Father Schenck has been a member of Our Mother of Sorrows Retreat League since 1939 when he made his first Passionist retreat at the monastery in Springfield, Mass., with a group of young men from St. Gertrude's Church, Wilson.
