Vicinity candidates to be ordained March 12 by Bishop Burke

Bishop to Ordain Five on March 12

The Most Rev. Joseph A. Burke, D.D., bishop of the Buffalo Diocese, will ordain four Western New York graduates of Our Lady of Angels Seminary at Niagara University to the Roman Catholic priesthood on Saturday, March 12.

Ceremonies will take place at 10 a.m. in St. Joseph's New Cathedral. The four are members of one of the last graduating classes from the Niagara campus, since the seminary will move, probably next year, to a new site near Albany.

The four vicinity ordinands are the Rev. Mr. Robert J. McArtney and the Rev. Mr. John Lewandowski of Buffalo, the Rev. Mr. John J. Fox of Kenmore and the Rev. Mr. John Sabino of Jamestown.

The Rev. Mr. Nicholas A. Rossello of Endicott completes the five-member seminary graduating class. Bishop Burke will ordain him to the clergy at the service, too. The Rt. Rev. Msgr. L. Colagiola of Jamestown will serve as the Rev. Mr. Rossello's sponsor.

All four of the new priests from this vicinity will celebrate their first Solemn High Masses Sunday, March 13, in their home churches. All attended the Diocesan Preparatory Seminary before entering Our Lady of Angels.

The Rev. Mr. McArtney is the son of Mrs. James H. McArtney of 18 DuPont St. He attended

St. Nicholas parish school before starting seminary training. The Rev. Paul R. Jeunker of the Diocesan Preparatory Seminary will sponsor him at the ordination.

His first Mass will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. in St. Nicholas Church. The assisting clergy will consist of the Revs. Joseph Harrington, Walter L. Matsuzak and Robert W. Steinbach and the Very Rev. Msgr. William J. Snyder of Jewettville. A reception will take place in the school hall from 3:30 to 6:30 that afternoon.

The Rev. Mr. Lewandowski is the son of Mr. and Mrs. John Lewandowski Sr. of 58 Wex Ave. He attended St. John Kanty School and East High. The Rev. Thomas E. Kemp of Bishop Turner High will sponsor him.

He will celebrate his first Mass at noon in Holy Name Church. Assisting will be the Rev. William J. McClimont, C.M., of Niagara University; the Rev. Mr. Robert Hatela, the Rev. Mr. Raymond Kozlowski, Mr. Felix Szafran and Mr. Frank Endres.

A first blessing and reception will start at 5 p.m. in the school hall, with benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament to follow.

The Rev. Mr. Fox, son of Mr. and Mrs. Patrick J. Fox of 173 Westgate Rd., Kenmore, attended St. Paul's School in the village. The Rev. Charles Werth will sponsor him in the cathedral ceremony.

He will offer his first Solemn Mass at noon, with the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Timothy J. Ring preaching the sermon. The Revs. William H. Meegan, William C. McGarry and Terrance Gross also will participate.

The reception will take place in the school hall from 4 to 7 in the afternoon.

The Rev. Mr. Sabino, a Jamestown High graduate, is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Anthony Sabino of 177 Newton Ave., Jamestown. The Rev. Rupert Wright will sponsor him.
