

Seminararian to Be Ordained June 30

Rev. William W. Lanphear will be ordained on Sunday, June 30, in the North American College Chapel, Louvain, Belgium.

The son of Mrs. Walter E. Lanphear, 300 Berkshire Ave., and the late Walter E. Lanphear, he will be ordained by Most Rev. John P. Cody, Apostolic Administrator of the Archdiocese of New Orleans. He will be assisted by Very Rev. Paul D. Riedl, rector of the North American College.

Father Lanphear will offer his first solemn Mass on Sunday, Aug. 4, at 10:30 a.m. in St. Vincent de Paul Church. Rt. Rev. Msgr. Joseph P. McDonald, P.A., pastor, will be Archpriest. Rev. Albert E.
