

Priest Returns To Former Duty At Turner High

The Chancery of the Catholic Diocese of Buffalo said today the Rev. Nelson J. Kinmartin has resigned his pastorate at Our Lady of Fatima, Elba, and will return to Bishop Turner High School.

He was on the staff there a year ago when he accepted the Genesee County parish. He is expected to return to guidance work, which he directed for years at the boys' high school.

Father Kinmartin will be succeeded by Rev. David J. Scheider, a teacher at Notre Dame High School, Batavia, who has been named administrator of the parish.

He will remain on the high school faculty. Father Kinmartin will become a week-end assistant at St. Joseph's parish, University Heights.

In another change the Rev. Harold Wagner, an assistant chancellor of the diocese, was given the additional assignment of serving as chaplain at the Cantalician Center, a school for the mentally handicapped.

He has been week-end assistant at St. Joseph's, University Heights. The changes, made by Bishop James A. McNulty, are effective Monday.
